Rules:

- 1 Entries must be the work of exhibitor.
- 2 No mixes unless specified.
- 3 All entries to be placed on sturdy paper plates or foil covered cardboard in a **clear zip lock plastic bag. No glass plates will be accepted.**
- 4 Entry tags to be attached FIRMLY on OUTSIDE OF EXHIBIT but not on closing of the bag.
- 5 Judging will be for: General Appearance 25% (size, colour etc), Internal Appearance 25% (flaky, tenderness etc), Flavour 50% (pleasing).
- 6 Please advise the culinary arts chairperson if you wish to donate your baking (sections 1-18) for sale in our tea room.
- 7 ***Note*** - Due to reduced size requirements for competition, all baking will remain for the duration of the fair.
- 8 All exhibitors may pick up their baking Sunday after 7:15pm-8:30pm. **(Note- Rule #6).**
- 9 We strongly recommend that you do not consume the baking because of the prolonged lack of refrigeration.
- 10 Please bring your exhibitor registration form as confirmation of entry when picking up exhibits.
- 11 Cookie size-no larger than 6.75cm (3") and no smaller than 5cm (2")
- 12 ***Note*** Special sponsored sections (sections 20sp-30sp), will be refrigerated for the sponsor to pick up after judging on Friday. A sample judged piece will be left for display.
