#### **Fudge Recipe:**

- 1 3/4 cups-icing sugar
- Pinch of salt
- 1 1/4 teaspoon vanilla
- 1/4 cup cocoa
- 2 tablespoon milk
- 1/4 cup butter
- 1/4 cup walnuts (optional)
- In a 4 cup (1L) measuring cup, stir sugar, cocoa, salt, milk and vanilla until partially blended.
- Put cut up pieces of butter on top. Microwave on high for 2 minutes.
- Stir vigorously until smooth.
- Pour into wax paper lined loaf pan. Chill one (1) hour before cutting
