

### **30 – CULINARY ARTS**

#### **Rules:**

1. Entries must be the work of exhibitor.
2. No mixes unless specified.
3. All entries to be placed on sturdy paper plates or foil covered cardboard in a **clear zip lock plastic bag. No glass plates will be accepted or entries with Saran wrap.**
4. Entry tags to be attached **FIRMLY** on **OUTSIDE OF EXHIBIT** but not on closing of the bag.
5. Judging will be for: General Appearance 25% (size, colour etc.), Internal Appearance 25% (flaky, tenderness etc.), Flavour 50% (pleasing).
6. Please advise the culinary arts chairperson if you wish to donate your baking (sections 1-18) for sale in our tea room.
7. **\*Note\*** - Due to reduced size requirements for competition, all baking will remain for the duration of the fair.
8. All exhibitors may pick up their baking (section 1-18) Sunday after 7:15pm-8:00pm. (**Note- Rule #6**).
9. We strongly recommend that you do not consume the baking because of the prolonged lack of refrigeration.
10. Please bring your exhibitor registration form as confirmation of entry when picking up exhibits.
11. Cookie size-no larger than 6.75cm (3”) and no smaller than 5cm (2”)
12. **\*Note\*** Special sponsored sections (sections 20SP-31SP), will be refrigerated for the sponsor to pick up after judging on Friday after 3:00pm. A sample piece will be judged and a small piece will be left for display. The remaining item can be picked up on Fri between 3 – 4pm.

Submit a whole pie-1 piece will be judged & a sample piece will be for display. If the pie is **not** property of the sponsor -the remaining pie can be picked up on the Fri after judging between 3-4pm.
