

CLASS 36 – YOUTH FAIR

Rules:

1. Age **MUST** be clearly printed on the front of the entry tag, especially for consideration in the **New** “Most Points” prize. Enter only in the child’s own age group or older. Exhibitor tags must be firmly attached to work
2. Youth fair exhibitors must have their own exhibitor number. No exhibitor fee will be charged for this class. ***NEW*** An exhibitor fee will not be charged if exhibitor wishes to show in open (adult) classes.
3. Read the rules carefully for what is required. Not following instructions may result in disqualification or lower placement.
4. One entry per exhibitor in each section and it must be recent work of the exhibitor.
5. Spelling and neatness counts on all entries.
6. **Note:** The work must be made by the child.

AGE 4 AND UNDER AS OF JUNE 30th of current year

Print age on front of entry tag (especially for the New “Most Points” prize)

Prizes: 1st \$5; 2nd \$4; 3rd \$3; 4th \$2

1SP. JUNGLE OASIS SPECIAL Outline your foot, cut it out and decorate it using nature items - i.e. seeds, dry leaves, small sticks, etc. Prizes: 1st Three entry passes to Jungle Oasis, 2nd Two entry passes, 3rd One entry pass

2. On a paper plate, display your favourite crazy looking vegetable, grown at your house – i.e. multi leg carrot.

3SP: THE MAPLES WOMEN’S INSTITUTE SPECIAL: Make a piggy bank out of recycled materials. Prize: 1st \$6; 2nd \$5; 3rd \$4; 4th \$3; 5th \$2

4SP: ZEHR’S SPECIAL: Leaf Creatures – Find different leaves, glue onto construction paper, then using any medium create your own creatures. Come up with a name for them. Prizes: 1st \$6; 2nd \$4; 3rd \$3; 4th \$2

AGE 7 AND UNDER AS OF JUNE 30th, of current year

Print age on front of entry tag (especially for the New “Most Points” prize)

Prizes: 1st \$5; 2nd \$4; 3rd \$3; 4th \$ 2

5. 5 root vegetables, on a paper plate, that you have grown i.e. carrots, beets

6 Colouring Page – Colour a page from a colouring book that is related to the theme “Simpler Times” and mount on Construction paper.

7SP: JUNGLE OASIS SPECIAL Use Burrs to sculpt a Teddy Bear. Prizes: 1st Three entry passes to Jungle Oasis, 2nd Two entry passes, 3rd One entry pass

8SP: POTTERY PARTY STUDIO SPECIAL: Hand painted and fired ceramic item i.e. dish, figurine, box, Christmas decoration, etc 1st \$20 Gift Certificate; 2nd \$15 Gift Certificate; 3rd \$10 Gift Certificate

9: With parents' permission, decorate a piece of fabric, or a pillowcase using paints or markers, to make a banner or flag to represent "Simpler Times". Not to exceed 80cm x 50cm.

10: Create your favourite animal all to be made with yarn or string, glued to paper.

11SP: ZEHRS PICTURE SPECIAL: Create a picture using beans or seeds glued on a paper plate showing your favourite quilt pattern/Block.

Prize: 1st \$5; 2nd \$4; 3rd \$3; 4th \$2; 5th \$1

AGE 10 AND UNDER AS OF JUNE 30th of current year

Print age on front of entry tag (especially for the New "Most Points" prize)

Prizes: 1st \$5; 2nd \$4; 3rd \$3; 4th \$2

12. Collect, identify and mount, on a plate or tray (not to exceed 45 cm x 45 cm), 6 different rocks. Include a description of one of the rocks.

13. Finger Puppets – Using an old glove create a barn on the palm and farm animals on each finger using any medium.

14. Cherry tomatoes, on a paper plate and grown by you.

15. A futuristic farm scene that you have made from LEGO - not from a kit.

Minimum size 15cm x 15 cm Maximum size 30 cm x 30 cm

16 A crocheted or knitted scarf.

17SP: Make a diorama using recycled and non recycled materials. Decorate it to represent the theme "Simpler Times".

18SP: YOUTH CHAIRPERSON'S SPECIAL: Paper airplane contest- submit an airplane that will fly the furthest as determined by the Fair's judge. Prize: 1st \$6; 2nd \$5; 3rd \$4; 4th \$3; 5th \$2

19SP: DUFFERIN COUNTY DAIRY PRODUCERS SPECIAL: Create a picture of a milkshake, float or sundae. Label the ingredients and include at least 2 dairy products. Neatness counts. Picture not to exceed 30cm x 30cm. Prizes: 1st \$5; 2nd \$4; 3rd \$3; 4th \$2

20SP: A print out (black and white or colour) of yourself green screened into a scene designed by you that depicts the theme "Simpler Times". Can be done at school.

21SP: DUFFERIN GARDEN CENTRE SPECIAL: "Nature's Beauty" Collect 3 different leaves, name and display them creatively on an 8 1/2"x11" paper. Include a picture of one of the "host" trees. Prizes: 1st \$5; 2nd \$4; 3rd \$3

AGE 11 AND UNDER AS OF JUNE 30th, of current year

Print age on front of entry tag (especially for the New “Most Points” prize)

22SP: PAINTED PONY QUILTWORKS (JUDY MACLEOD)SPECIAL:

Quilted item of choice, any size or technique. Quilting may be done by the exhibitor or another person. Please indicate name of quilter on back of entry tag.

Prize: 1st \$10; 2nd \$6; 3rd \$4

23SP: ZEHR'S CONSTRUCTION SPECIAL: Build a Popsicle Stick Bridge to span a 20 cm gap. Using only 80 popsicle sticks. It must be able to hold a weight during judging at the fair. If yours is damaged from weight testing at school include a note with all relevant information including how much weight it was able to hold. Scientific construction principles will be considered in judging. Prize: 1st \$7; 2nd \$6; 3rd \$4; 4th \$3

AGE 12 AND UNDER AS OF JUNE 30th, of current year

Print age on front of entry tag (especially for the New “Most Points” prize)

Prizes: 1st \$5; 2nd \$4; 3rd \$3; 4th \$2

24. 5 of the same tree fruits, on a paper plate, grown at your house i.e. apples, pears etc.

25. A school science project that you are proud of.

26SP. DUFFERIN FAMILY CHIROPRACTIC SPECIAL: Make your own lip balm, submit in an appropriate container with the recipe written out on a card.

Prizes: 1st \$7; 2nd \$6; 3rd \$4; 4th \$3

27SP: ZEHR'S ORIGAMI SPECIAL: An item of origami that is a bird or animal.

Prizes: 1st \$7; 2nd \$6; 3rd \$4; 4th \$3

28: Make a small hand sewn child's toy or stuffie. It may be from a kit or a class.

29SP: HILLCREST PRIVATE SCHOOL SPECIAL: On 8½” x 11” paper, using cursive writing, reproduce the following poem. Neatness and spelling count.

Print age on front of entry tag (especially for the New “Most Points” prize)

32SP: PAINTED PONY QUILTWORKS (JUDY MACLEOD) SPECIAL -

Quilted item of choice, any size or technique. Quilting may be done by the exhibitor or another person. Please indicate name of quilt on back of entry tag.

Prize 1st \$10; 2nd \$6; 3rd \$4

Print age on front of entry tag (especially for the New “Most Points” prize)

DICKIE) SPECIAL: Survival Bracelet, on a card, describe its features for use in a survival situation. Prizes 1st \$8, 2nd \$6, 3rd \$4, 4th \$2

34 Soap Carving – using a standard soap bar

35. Painting on glass item. May be a kit.

36SP. **BOOSTER JUICE SPECIAL:** Use a discarded book & up cycle it into art or something useful. Prize: 1st Gift Certificate for 3 regular smoothies, 2nd Gift Certificate for 2 regular smoothies, 3rd Gift Certificate for 1 regular smoothie

ENGINEERING CHALLENGE: Make a functioning vehicle from any materials, with movement but, must not need a push or batteries in order to move. May be a kit. Not to exceed – 45cm x45cm x 45cm. Prize: 1st \$15; 2nd \$10; 3rd \$7; 4th \$5; 5th \$3

Minimum size 22cm x 28 cm

Maximum size 28 cm x 44cm without border.

1. Label clearly on the **back** of your poster – exhibitor’s name, school grade (or “home school grade”), home address and telephone number.

2. Each entry **must** be centered on card stock or Bristol board exposing a 5.5cm border on all four sides.

3. Entries will be judged on:

- Overall Appearance – 50 points

- Hand Drawn – 35 points

- OAAS Criteria (size, material, theme) – 15 points

Prizes (at Orangeville Fair)

Youth up to Grade 4: 1st \$5; 2nd \$3

Youth Grade 5 to Grade 8: 1st \$5; 2nd \$3

Youth Grade 9 to Grade 12: 1st \$5; 2nd \$3

Note: The winning posters at Orangeville Fair, for each age group, will be eligible to enter the District #5 competition in October 2019.

Prizes: 1st \$25 2nd \$15 3rd \$10 (unconfirmed)

The winner at the District #5 level will compete for prizes in February 2020 at the: Ontario Association of Agricultural Societies Convention.
