- 1/4 cup walnuts (optional)
- Pinch of salt
- 1/4 cup cocoa
- 1/4 cup butter

In a 4 cup (1L) measuring cup, stir sugar, cocoa, salt, milk and vanilla until partially blended. Put cut up pieces of butter on top. Microwave on high for 2 minutes. Stir vigorously until smooth. Pour into wax paper lined loaf pan. Chill one (1) hour before cutting

General Rules for Classes 38 & 39:

1. Entries submitted by a professional photographer will not be accepted.
2. Entry MUST be the work of the exhibitor and taken within the last two years and has not been previously entered.
3. Only one entry per section per exhibitor.
4. Youth exhibitors enter only in their own section or higher.
5. Youth exhibitors must have their own exhibitor number and no exhibitor fee will be charged. If they enter Class 39 or other open classes the exhibitor fee of \$5 is charged.
