- 2. Each exhibitor must pay a fee of \$5 upon registration at the event.
- 3. All others pay gate admission.
- Entrants must have a Certificate of Proof for \$2,000,000 liability insurance.
- 5. Scales will be operated in accordance with C.C.H.P.A. guidelines.
- 6. Heavy and Light Classes may be pulled together at the discretion of the Judge and officials. In such case, teams compete and are judged within their own class only.
