Sections:

Sections 1 – 3 Sponsored by Sarah Ebbs RMT

1. A painting, any subject and any medium
2. A painting, drawing or other craft interpreting the fair theme 'Butterflies and Butter t Tarts'
3. A drawing or sketch using charcoal or pencil in any subject matter.
4. A drawing or sketch using coloured pencil, pastels, crayons, or other coloured mediums.
5. A page from an adult colouring book, done in marker, coloured pencil or crayon
6. A piece of folk art. Using any materials and any subject matter.
7. A piece of pottery or a project that uses glass, can be functional or artistic.
8. A piece of jewellery using any technique and materials other than beading. Can include friendship bracelets.
9. A piece of beading such as bookmarks, jewellery, belts, etc.
10. A piece of wood working or metal work.
11. An animal or insect house, such as a bird house, bee house, bat house, butterfly house, etc. Can use any materials except recycled materials.
12. A painted or decorated piece, such as ceramics, bird house, wood projects, etc. May be pre-made, to be judged on painting/decoration.
13. A box or basket made from any material or technique.

14. A project made from recycled materials, such as a bird house, garden ornament, stepping stone, jewellery, a toy, etc.
15. A handmade toy, such as a doll, stuffed animal, truck, puzzle, etc. using any materials (include samples when appropriate).
16. A tote, purse or bag made using any technique and any materials (include samples).
17. A fibre project, using any material or technique that is not represented in another section of the fair, such as a rug, weaving, felting, macramé, etc. (include thread/material samples).
18. A piece of cross stitch, needlepoint, embroidery, or punch needle finished in a frame or hoop. (Include thread samples).

19. A Holiday decoration, such as a wreath, center piece, party favours, garland, tree topper, etc. Can represent any holiday and use any technique and materials, no fresh flowers.
20. A Christmas tree or holiday ornament, made from recycled materials.
21. A Christmas tree or holiday ornament made using any technique.
22. A Santa Claus, Snowperson or Angel made using any technique and materials.
23. A Christmas stocking or gift bag. Made using any technique and materials.
24. Something made from recycled greeting or holiday cards, wrapping paper or post cards.
25. A handmade greeting or holiday (including Christmas) card for any occasion with a message enclosed and an envelope.

Section 26 & 27 Sponsored by Horizon Landscape Services

One (1) mounted and decorated page of self-composed poetry or a one-page short story. May either be handwritten or done by computer. Any subject matter.



27. A one page in a sleeve from a scrap book or memory book, any theme or subject matter.



28SP. **MARIE TRIMBLE MEMORIAL SPECIAL:** A project of cross stitch, needlepoint, embroidery or other needle work i.e. Pillow, bookmark, tablecloth, etc. (samples of thread included).
